

The rules

Rule 1: The 24th edition of Prom'Classic, a 10 km, is organized by AZUR SPORT ORGANISATION with the collaboration of Nice and will occur next January, 07th, 2024. This race could be run with or without chrono.

Rule 2: This course of 10 km measured and conformed to the French act and to the national commission is a qualificative test for the French Championships for 2024.

Rule 3: The race is opened to licensed and unlicensed runners born in 2008 and before. Each category will benefit from a particular classification with the agreement of FFA. Controls could be carried during the race in order to ensure the perfect conditions of race. The starting will be common for all the runners, at 09.00 am on the Promenade des Anglais. They will be 7 start's waves in different areas (Areas <32' ; <35h / <43f & Areas 35'-40' // Areas 40'- 45' // Areas 45' – 50 // Areas 50' – 55' // Areas 55' – 1h00 // Areas 1h00 and more). The race will be officially finished at 11.30 am. All runners participate to the competition under their own responsibility.

The participation to the sporting tests organized by the sporting federations is subordinated to a medical certificate dated from less than one year by the day of the race, at January, 08th, 2023 and mentioned the none contraindication to the practice of running in competition. The original or the photocopy of the medical certificate must be kept for one year by the organizers.

For the 10km without chrono, there is no need to present a certificate or a license. And it's the same for the runner under 18 years-old. For this runners, only a parental autorisation and a healthy document must be presented.

Rule 4: For the 10km with chrono, the registration SUBJECTED TO AVAILABILITY fee is 19€ for the 1 000 first registraters then 24€ for the 3 000 next registraters and 27 € until January the 3rd.

For the 10km without chrono, the registration SUBJECTED TO AVAILABILITY fee is 17€ for the 100 first registraters then 20€ for the 200 next registraters and 23 € until January the 3rd.

An extra charge of 1€ will be apply for each registration. All these extra charges will be collect for the "Banque Alimentaire".

The bibs could be pick up on the opened on the Expo in possession of a valid medical certificate on Friday, January, 5th (from 1 pm to 7 pm) and Saturday, January, 6th (from 9am to 7 pm) until Sunday, January, 7th for foreign runners only (from 7 to 8.15 am).

No registration will be accepted on the D-DAY.

Rule 5: The jury is composed of a referee FFA judge whose decision is final. He is assisted by official judges and race stewards appointed by the FFA. Refreshment spots will be located every 5km as well as on the finish area.

After the passage of the last organization car, competitors should respect the Highway Code. Time limit 1:30:00 for the 10km with chrono and until 11.30am for the 10km without chrono.

The Championship system (will be incorporated in the bib in your bib number) will be used for timing.

Rule 6: Road safety is under control of the police department. Medical services are provided by Civil Protection, municipal police assisted of a regulator doctor. They can stop any competitor from continuing the race for medical reasons.

Rule 7: The timing system will be used for timing by a person affiliated to the F.F.A.. Each competitor will be given a chip when collecting starting documents which will be activated in an automatically way when the start line will be crossed. The chip will be used as control system on different check point positioned on the course. Competitors failing to follow the course will be disqualified.

Rule 8: The organizers have taken out a civil liability insurance policy in accordance with current legislation. All the runners have to subscribe to insurance. The organizers are exempt from all responsibility in case of an accident following to bad physical conditions.

Rule 9: Each entry is considered as non-transferable and final and implies full acceptance of the rules. The entries could not be refunded.

Rule 10: Bicycles or motorized vehicles are strictly forbidden except for the vehicles from the organization.

Rule 11: CNIL: According to the data-processing and freedom law of the 6th January 1978, all entrants have the right to consult and to rectify all their personal data. By our intermediary, you could receive propositions from others enterprises or associations.

Rule 12 : PERSONAL DATA: All competitors, their relatives and the public expressly and exclusively grant to AZUR SPORT ORGANISATION and its assigns such as media or partners, the irrevocable right to use a competitor's name, likeness, biography, factually or otherwise in connection with the production, the distribution and exploitation of the pictures related to the Prom'Classic and its animations all the week-end long, world-wide in any and all devices, media, whatsoever, now known or hereafter known, for the entire duration of the protection period currently awarded by legislative or regulatory bodies, court decision and/or arbitrages in any country, and currently existing of future international conventions, including eventual prolongations which may be made to this duration.

Rule 13: All competitors acknowledge and accept all the clauses of the rules. All the competitors agree, on their honor, not to anticipate the start and to cover the full distance before crossing the finishing line.

Rule 14: Sustainability Through his races, Azur Sport Organisation is committed in sustainability. Runners participating to ASO races accept those commitments

Rule 15 – Cancellation option

Each runner may subscribe to an optional "Insurance Refund in case of cancellation" allowing him/her to cancel his/her registration.

The insurance will refund at 90% of the price of the registration. Any options won't be refund. The insurance will be apply for the next case : deasies, injury, accident of travel, death of a member of the family. A medical certificate or un document will be sent to CIMALP COMMUNICATION – Prom Classic until Saturday 06th January.

This insurance isn't taken into consideration if the event is to be partially or totally cancelled (see rules 16 and 17).

Rule 16 – Pandemic event cancellation

In the case where the event would be cancelled because of a pandemic situation (population lockdown, non-gathering rules, ...), the organization would not refund 100% of the amount, including the possible options, minus the transaction fees.

Rule 17 – Major fact event cancellation

If the event must be cancelled for a case of absolute necessity or for a motive independent from the will of the organization, apart from the cases listed in the rule 16, then neither refund of registration could be made, nor any compensation received, including those who would have taken the cancellation option.

Rule 18 – Rules modification

The organization has the right to change those rules at any moment, and whatever the reasons. Registered people would then be informed of those changes by all possible means at the disposal of the organization.

Rule 19 – Sanitary rules

Regarding the sanitary rules, the organization will follow the governmental instructions in place at the date of the race, setting up all the necessary measures in order to offer a maximal protection for the runners, volunteers and to all the people involved in this event.

Rule 20: The participation to the Prom'Classic implicates the express approval of the official regulation by every runner.
